# Knebworth House

ONE OF ENGLAND'S MOST BELOVED STATELY HOMES,
KNEBWORTH HOUSE IS A BEAUTIFUL GOTHIC MANSION
SITUATED JUST 29 MILES NORTH OF LONDON OFF THE A1(M)
AT STEVENAGE.



It is perhaps most famous today for its legendary open-air rock concerts, but on a more genteel note, it was also the home of Victorian novelist, playwright and politician, Edward Bulwer Lytton — author of the words 'The pen is mightier than the sword', who transformed his home into the unique place we see today. Other famous Lyttons include Constance Lytton, the suffragette, and Robert Lytton, the Viceroy of India who proclaimed Queen Victoria Empress of India at the Great Delhi Durbar of 1877.

With its turrets, domes and gargoyles silhouetted against the sky, the romantic exterior of Knebworth House does little to prepare the visitor for what to expect inside. The house has stood for many years longer than the Victorian decoration suggests, and the stucco hides from view a red brick house dating back to Tudor times.

Every generation of the Lytton family has left something of its style and taste, making Knebworth an extraordinary walk through 500 years of British history. Stories and heirlooms reflect the family's contribution to literature, politics and Foreign Service, as well as visits by characters as diverse as Elizabeth I, Charles Dickens, Winston Churchill and Robbie Williams.

#### The Gardens

There have been gardens at Knebworth House since at least the seventeenth century, but the present layout dates largely from the Edwardian era. The architect Sir Edwin Lutyens, who married into the Lytton family, simplified



the ornate beds and statuary of the Victorian garden with lawns and avenues of pollarded lime trees. Popular features of the twenty-five acres now include a maze, the organically run walled kitchen garden and the Gertrude Jekyll Herb Garden designed over one hundred years ago in 1907.

## Dinosaur Trail

Seventy-two life-size dinosaurs can be found grazing amongst the rhododendrons and the redwoods at Knebworth! Children of all ages will love exploring the woodland paths, whilst learning about the T-rex, the woolly mammoth and other fascinating prehistoric creatures.

# The Park

With 250 acres of rolling hills and ancient chestnut and lime avenues, there's more than enough space to offer a quiet refuge for country picnics and dog walking (visitors are asked not to take pets into the gardens and to use leads in the park). You might catch a glimpse of grazing herds of red and sika deer.

The Adventure Playground

Children can also run loose amongst the swings, slides and walkways of the adventure playground featuring Tarzan trails, a miniature railway, thrill slides, and bouncy castle.

Knebworth House & Gardens are maintained by The Knebworth House Education and Preservation Trust, a charity established by the Lytton Cobbold family with the support of the Hertfordshire local authorities.

# What does your ticket price cover?

Your ticket will give you full access to all of the Fair Marquees, as well as access to all of the Knebworth Grounds and Gardens. Should you wish to take a tour of the house we have negotiated a brilliant discount for you to be able to upgrade your tickets for just £2.50! All you need to do is show your Annual Fair Button Badge on the day at Knebworth's ticket office and you will be able to join the tours of the house which take place at regular intervals throughout both days.

- [1] Ticket prices cover entry into all areas of the Fair, but only the Grounds and Gardens of Knebworth House.
- [2] Separate discounted tickets are available to view the house, direct from Knebworth House on the day. These supplement tickets are sold at the house entrance door rather than at the main park entrance ticketing points.
- [3] Please note that tickets are non-refundable.
- [4] Discounted tickets will not be available on the day. Normal Knebworth House full admission prices will be charged on the day.
- [5] Dogs are welcome in the park on leads but are not allowed in the gardens or house.
- [6] Book your tickets as early as possible to avoid disappointment.



Knebworth House & Park are accessed direct from the Junction 7 roundabout of the A1(M) motorway at Stevenage South, 29 miles north of London. There are signs on both carriageways of the motorway.

#### Sat Nav Users

By Road

If you are using a Sat Nav system, use the postcode of the Stevenage Novotel at Junction 7 — SG1 2AX — not the Knebworth House postcode.

### By Rail

The nearest rail station is Stevenage, two miles
Knebworth Park. There is a taxi rank at the station.
Non-stop Inter-City and local services run to Stevenage
Station from London's King's Cross Station around every
30 minutes. There are also frequent Inter-City connections
on the East Coast main line from Cambridge, York, Leeds,
Newcastle, Edinburgh and Glasgow.

## Disabled Access

Disabled permit holders will be given priority parking as close to the Fair site as is possible. As an historic building, the house regrettably has no lift to the first floor. However, Knebworth's history can be conveyed to visitors with impaired mobility on the ground floor. Wheelchair accessible toilets are located at the entrance of the gardens, in the house and at the adventure playground. The Garden paths are mostly gravel.
